This contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Services Act funds. (3% Cost of Living Adjustment)


BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing opportunities for social engagement and linkage to mental health and social services to isolated older adults in West Contra Costa County. On June 14, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74–353-8 with Lifelong Medical Care, for the period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31,
