Subject: Grant Award #29-603-2 with United States Department of Housing and Urban Development

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Grant Award #29 603-2 (CA1394L9T051702) with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), for McKinney-Vento Act funds, to pay County an amount not to exceed \$550,344, for the County's Continuum of Care Coordinated Entry Project, for the period from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Approval of this award will result in an amount not to exceed \$550,344, payable to the County from HUD McKinney-Vento Act funds for County's Continuum of Care Program. (Required \$137,586 County match)

**BACKGROUND:**

Contra Costa County's Continuum of Care (CoC), through its Inter-jurisdictional Council on Homelessness was awarded funds for the Coordinated Entry System (CES) project. The County's CES project has achieved successes in key strategies from the 2014 Strategic Plan Update, including implementation of a CES to stream line access to housing and services,
