Subject: Grant Agreement #28-375 with the Office of Statewide Health Planning & Development

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Grant Agreement #28-375 (#17-82371) with the Office of Statewide Health Planning & Development (OSHPD) to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$15,000, including agreeing to indemnify OSHPD, for the Health Careers Training Program (HCTP) in West Contra Costa County, for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This agreement will result in up to \$15,000 of funding for the HCTP. No County match required.

BACKGROUND:

Health disparities are associated with poor education outcomes, residents face disproportionate rates of preventable chronic illness such as heart disease, obesity, and cancer. The HCTP aims to continue efforts to advance health career pathways and youth professional development in a community most impacted by health inequities. Project goals include: 1) facilitate curriculum to at least 100 West Contra Costa Unified School District students focused on exploration of public health, behavioral health, clinical and emergency
