FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Realignment funds.

BACKGROUND:

For a number of years, the County has contracted with medical, dental and mental health specialists to provide specialized professional services, which are not otherwise available.

On June 5, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-562 with Emily Watters, M.D. for the provision of outpatient psychiatric services to mentally ill adults in Contra Costa County's homeless shelters through July 31, 2019.
