BACKGROUND:

While reviewing previously designated parking spaces for disabled persons on public roadways, it was determined that a disabled persons parking space was no longer needed. Public Works Traffic Engineering staff conducted a site visit and confirmed the disabled resident who originally requested the space no longer lives at the property. Therefore, in conformance with established policy, Traffic Engineering recommends removing the
