**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

RESCIND Traffic Resolution No. 2007/4250, adopted December 4, 2007, which prohibited parking or stopping at all times on a portion of Third Street (Road No. 1795G), except for those vehicles of individuals with disabilities, as recommended by the Public Works Director, Rodeo area.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

No fiscal impact.

**BACKGROUND:**

While reviewing previously designated parking spaces for disabled persons on public roadways, it was determined that a disabled persons parking space was no longer needed. Public Works Traffic Engineering staff conducted a site visit and confirmed the disabled resident who originally requested the space no longer lives at the property. Therefore, in conformance with established policy, Traffic Engineering recommends removing the
