Subject: RESCIND Traffic Resolution No. 2008/4263 for Third Street (Road No. 1795G), Rodeo area.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

RESCIND Traffic Resolution No. 2008/4263, adopted June 17, 2008, which prohibited parking or stopping at all times on a portion of Third Street (Road No. 1795G), except for those vehicles of individuals with disabilities, as recommended by the Public Works Director, Rodeo area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND:

While reviewing previously designated parking spaces for disabled persons on public roadways, it was determined that a disabled persons parking space was no longer needed. Public Works Traffic Engineering staff conducted a site visit and confirmed the disabled resident who originally requested the space no longer lives at the property. Therefore, in conformance with established policy, Traffic Engineering recommends removing the restriction on parking at this location.
