Subject: Grant Award #28-378 from Kaiser Foundation Hospitals

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Grant Agreement #28-378 (Kaiser #20660527) with Kaiser Foundation Hospitals, to pay the County in an amount not to exceed \$40,000 for the East County Moves Program, for the period from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this grant agreement will result in an amount not to exceed \$40,000 in funding from Kaiser Foundation Hospitals. A County match of \$7,458 is required.

BACKGROUND:

The goal of the East County Moves Program is to increase the knowledge of, access to, and occurrence of healthy food sources and outdoor sites for physical activity among low-income residents in Pittsburg and Bay Point; and increase capacity of Healthy & Livable Pittsburg agencies to evaluate health programming and seek funding to increase further offerings.
