Subject: Contract with STAND! For Families Free of Violence for Phase III Lethality Assessment Program

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with STAND! For Families Free of Violence, a Non-Profit Corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$310,000 to provide the continued implementation of the Phase III Lethality Assessment Program for Domestic Violence Homicide Prevention for the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The funds allocated for this contract are 100% federal funds, from a Department of Justice grant, CFDA #16.590.

BACKGROUND:

The Contra Costa Alliance to End Abuse (Alliance), formerly Zero Tolerance for Domestic Violence Initiative, applied for and received funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women (OVW), Domestic Violence Homicide Prevention Demonstration (Project) in 2013. The Project has been implemented in phases - an assessment phase (Phase I) and an implementation phase (Phase II). OVW completed Phase I in September 2014 and selected the Alliance as one of four sites to participate in Phase II
