RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract #27-757-5 with Armen Serebrakian, M.D. (dba Bay Area Hearing Services), an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, to provide audiology services for Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members for the period September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On November 8, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-757-4 with Armen Serebrakian, M.D. (dba Bay Area Hearing Services), to provide audiology services for CCHP Members, for the period from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2018.

Approval of Contract #27-757-5 will allow the contractor to continue providing audiology services through August 31, 2020.
