APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #24-751-87 with Anka Behavioral Health, Incorporated, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$4,184,765, to provide community services, support programs and residential mental health services to County clients for the period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, and includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$2,092,383.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 62% by Mental Health Realignment and 38% by Federal Medi-Cal. (Rate increase)


BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing a continuum of services to residents transitioning from crisis residential care to transitional residential care and keeps these clients out of higher levels of care, including state hospitals.
