RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #22–137–52 with Meals on Wheels Diablo Region, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$439,118, to provide home-delivered meals for the Senior Nutrition Program, for the period from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, which includes a three-month automatic extension through September 30, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$109,780.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is 100% federally funded under Title III-C 2 of the Older Americans Act of 1965. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing home-delivered meals on 250 serving days, to an average of 800 senior citizens, to ensure they receive at least one third of their daily nutritional requirements.



automatic extension through September 30, 2018.

Approval of Novation Contract #22-137-52 replaces the automatic extension under the prior contract and allows the contractor to continue coordinating client intake and meal delivery services to homebound elders through June 30, 2019.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, County's homebound senior citizens will not receive Senior Nutrition Program meals, which provide at least one third of their daily nutrition.
