#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The annual cost of this position is \$89,623 with pension cost of \$17,788. This cost is funded by the Mental Health Services Act Innovation funds.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Health Services Department is requesting to add one permanent Mental Health Community Support Worker II position in the Center for Recovery and Empowerment (CORE) Program of the Behavioral Health Division. CORE is an intensive outpatient treatment program offering intensive, transitional and continuing care to adolescents dually diagnosed with substance use and mental health disorders. Services are provided by a multi-disciplinary team, and include individual, group and family therapy, and linkage to community services. The MH Community Support Worker II will provide peer support and education to consumers and family members, develop and facilitate support groups and
