RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-306-29 with Per Diem Staffing Systems, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$800,000 to provide temporary respiratory therapists, nursing, and other medical classifications at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Centers for the period July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On July 18, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-306-27 with Per Diem Staffing Systems, Inc., to provide temporary respiratory therapists, nursing and other categories of medical services to cover employee sick leaves, vacations and workers compensation leaves, at CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
