RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #26-347-32 with Cross Country Staffing, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 to provide temporary medical and specialty staffing services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Centers, for the period from July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On July 11, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-347-31 with Cross Country Staffing, Inc., to provide temporary medical staffing services, including registered nursing, and Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) nursing services at CCRMC and Health Centers for the period from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

Approval of Contract #26-347-32 will allow the contractor to continue providing temporary medical and specialty staffing services through December 31, 2018. This contract includes
