Subject: Contract #24-704-6 with Kimberly Loda, M.D.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #24-704-6 with Kimberly Loda, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$262,080, to provide outpatient psychiatric care services to adults in West County for the period from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Realignment. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On September 12, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #24-704-4 (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreement #24-704-5) with Kimberly Loda, M.D., for the provision of outpatient psychiatric care services including diagnosing, counseling, evaluation, and providing medical and therapeutic treatment to adults in West County for the period from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018. Approval of Contract #24-704-6 will allow the Contractor to continue to provide outpatient psychiatric care services to adults in West County, through September 30, 2019.
