Subject: Approve Encroachment Permit for the Jersey Island Road Bridge Repair Project, Oakley area.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute an encroachment permit from City of Oakley in connection with the Jersey Island Road Bridge Repair Project, Oakley area. County Project No. 0662-6U4134 (District III)

FISCAL IMPACT:

The project is funded 100% by Local Road Funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Contra Costa County Public Works Department (County) was notified by Caltrans Office of Structure Maintenance and Investigations on November 8, 2018, that the Jersey Island Road Bridge requires an immediate northbound lane closure and load restriction posting due to Caltrans' recent findings of multiple deteriorated bridge piles, until such a time when the bridge substructure repairs could be completed. As a result, County must install temporary traffic signals and lane closure warning devices on both ends of the bridge, including the south approach where City of Oakley has the jurisdiction. County is required to obtain an encroachment permit from the City of Oakley in order to implement the
