RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a purchase order amendment with Cintas Fire Protection to increase the payment limit from \$99,000 to a new payment limit of \$140,000 for fire extinguisher maintenance, with no change to the original term April 1, 2017 through January 31, 2019, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This cost is to be funded through Public Works Facilities budget and user departments. (100% Department User Fees)

BACKGROUND:

Public Works Fleet and Facilities Services are responsible for fire extinguisher maintenance in County buildings and vehicles. Fire extinguishers must, by law, be inspected and certified annually. Public Works bid this as Bidsync #1501-117, and awarded Cintas Fire Protection. This commodity was bid for two years with three possible one year extensions. This award is in the middle of the second possible renewal. Facilities Services has exhausted the funds
