RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #76-579-2 with Jamal J. Zaka, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$182,000 to provide pulmonology services to Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa Health Centers patients for the period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

BACKGROUND:

On February 6, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #76-579-1 with Jamal J. Zaka, M.D., to provide pulmonology services, including but not limited to clinical coverage, consultation, training and on-call services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Contra Costa Health Centers, for the period from April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2019. Approval of Contract #76-579-2 will allow the Contractor to continue to provide pulmonology services at CCRMC and Contra Costa Health Centers through March 31, 2020.
