Subject: Amendment No. 3 to Contract #23-596-3 with Emocha Mobile Health, Inc.

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent, on behalf of the Health Services Director, to execute Amendment No. 3 to Software and Services Agreement #23-596-3 with Emocha Mobile Health, Inc., effective March 1, 2019, to increase the payment limit by \$93,960 for a new payment limit of \$250,440 for tuberculosis monitoring software, and to extend the original term of May 1, 2016 through April 30, 2019, by three years to April 30, 2022.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I.

**BACKGROUND:**

On February 6, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #23-596 (as amended by Administrative Amendment #23-596-1) with Emocha Mobile Health, Inc. for the Tuberculosis Monitoring and Outreach software through its Contractor-hosted system which allows the Health Services Department and patients to track laboratory measurements of the illness via telephone. Approval of Amendment No. 3 to Contract #23-596-3 will allow the County to have 10 County employee users of the software with an unlimited
