BACKGROUND:

Access to reliable cars is a necessary function for EHSD's Social Workers, where compliance to regulations and diligence in service to the Child Welfare System and Aging and Adult Service sectors of our community, require a variety of Social Worker interaction with children, aging adults, and their families and caregivers. Newer vehicles, on average, are more reliable and require less time being repaired. In addition, there are safety and personal damage issues when Social Workers use their personal cars for client transport or
