Subject: Contract with Lutheran Social Services of Northern California for Transitional Housing Assistance for Emancipated Youth

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Lutheran Social Services of Northern California, in an amount not to exceed \$264,600 to provide transitional housing assistance for emancipated youth for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is funded with entirely by State 2011 Realignment revenue and is included in the FY 2019/20 Employment and Human Services budget.

BACKGROUND:

AB 427 authorized Transitional Housing Program (THP) - Plus funds to reimburse counties that provide transitional housing services to emancipating foster youth. Contra Costa County has contracted with Lutheran Social Services of Northern California since 2007 to provide THP - Plus support services to emancipated foster youth, who are non-minor dependents, up to and including age 23, and have been referred by staff of EHSD Independent Living Skills Program.
