BACKGROUND:

The current '92 Ford F350 is designed for access in hard to reach areas. It is equipped with a winch, crane, and lift gate to aid in the recovery and removal of large containers of hazardous materials. The proposed vehicle will maintain the agility of the older vehicle with added power and safety features of a new vehicle.

The current vehicle will continue to be used with ageing parts and few safety features.
