RECOMMENDATION(S):

ADOPT Resolution No. 2019/162 authorizing the issuance and sale of "Walnut Creek School District General Obligation Bonds, Election of 2016, Series B (2019)" in an amount not to exceed \$20,000,000 by the Walnut Creek School District on its own behalf pursuant to Section 15140(b) of the Education Code.

FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND:

The Walnut Creek School District intends to issue General Obligation bonds to fund capital improvements throughout the District. The District has requested that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution authorizing the direct issuance and sale of bonds by the District on its own behalf as authorized by Section 15140(b) of the Education Code.

The District adopted a resolution on April 22, 2019 authorizing the sale and issuance of the bonds (copy attached). This issuance was approved by the voters as part of a \$60,000,000 bond measure listed on the June 7, 2016 ballot.
