BACKGROUND:

EHSD's current infrastructure of virtual servers is quickly approaching the system's capacity. Adding the additional capacity will enable EHSD to continue to grow its virtual server environment. This environment will enable EHSD to bring additional technology to staff and clients to include, but not limited to, video/voice conferencing, instant messaging, and virtual desktops.
