Subject: Consulting Service Agreement for BSK Associates

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**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a Consulting Services Agreement (“contract”) with BSK Associates (“BSK”), in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, for the period June 18, 2019 through June 18, 2022, to provide on-call geotechnical engineering services, Countywide. (Project Nos. Various)(All Districts)

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Work performed under this on-call contract is funded by developer fees, local, state and federal funds for road, flood control, and airport projects.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Public Works Department is involved in various projects in the County that require geotechnical engineering services for road, flood control, and airport projects. After a solicitation process, BSK was selected as one of eight firms to provide geotechnical engineering services on an “on-call” basis. The Consultant will be used to provide geotechnical engineering service as in-house expertise is not available. This on-call contract
