APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-911-29 with Thomas B. Hargrave, M.D., III, an individual, effective June 1, 2019, to amend Contract #26-911-28, to increase the payment limit by \$109,000, from \$335,000 to a new payment limit of \$444,000, with no change in the original term September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019.

BACKGROUND:

On July 24, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-911-28 with Thomas B. Hargrave, M.D., III, to provide gastroenterology services including consultation, training, on-call coverage services and medical procedures at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Centers for the period September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019.

Approval of Contract Amendment Agreement #26-911-29 will allow the Contractor to provide additional hours of gastroenterology services at CCRMC and Health Centers
