Subject: RESCIND Traffic Resolution No. 4091 for Rodeo Avenue (Road No. 1795AP), Rodeo area.

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

RESCIND Traffic Resolution No. 4091, adopted on November 2, 2004, which prohibited parking except for vehicles of individuals with disabilities, on a portion of the east side of Rodeo Avenue (Road No. 1795AP), as recommended by the Public Works Director, Rodeo area.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

No fiscal impact.

**BACKGROUND:**

It was determined that a parking space previously designated for disabled persons only, is no longer needed at this location. Public Works Transportation Engineering staff conducted a site visit confirming the Rodeo Veteran's Hall building is no longer at the requested location. Therefore, Public Works Transportation Engineering recommends removing the restricted parking based on established policy.
