Subject: Consulting Services Agreement with BKF Engineers, Countywide.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a Consulting Services Agreement (contract) with BKF Engineers (BKF), in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 to provide on-call transportation engineering services for the period July 9, 2019 through July 9, 2022, Countywide. (Project No. Various) (All Districts)

FISCAL IMPACT:

Work performed under this on-call contract is funded by developer fees, local road funds for road projects, and various other funds.

BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department is involved in various projects in the County that require transportation engineering expertise for road projects. After a solicitation process that included public outreach, BKF was selected as one of five firms to provide transportation engineering services on an on-call basis. The Consultant will be used to provide transportation engineering services as in-house expertise is not available. This on-call contract will be in effect for thirty-six months.
