RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Interagency Agreement #29-520-11 with the Pittsburg Unified School District, a government agency, to pay County an amount not to exceed \$154,500, to provide mental health intervention services for agency-designated, Special Education students with severe emotional needs in East County for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this Interagency Agreement will result in a total payment to the County in an amount not to exceed \$154,500. No County match is required.
