FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND:

Antioch School District has requested that Contra Costa Health Services, Public Health Clinic Services, provide Scoliosis Screening Clinics at their middle schools for their 7th grade girls and 8th grade boys, throughout the school year. By providing an outreach

On September 27, 2016, the Board of Supervisors approved Interagency Agreement #28-697-14 with Antioch Unified School District, for the Public Health Clinic Services Scoliosis Screening Project for its 7th and 8th grade students for the period from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2019.

Approval of Interagency Agreement #28-697-15 will allow Agency to offer continuous scoliosis-screening services to its students, through August 31, 2022.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this contract is not approved, the County will not receive funds in order to screen for scoliosis in approximately 1,400 7th and 8th grade students in Antioch Unified School District.
