Subject: Contract #74-475-78(3) with Remarkable Marriage and Family Institute

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #74-475-78(3) with Remarkable Marriage and Family Institute, a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$930,000, to provide Medi-Cal specialty mental health services for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded by 50% Federal Medi-Cal and 50% State Mental Health Realignment Funds. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On January 14, 1997, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution #97/17, authorizing the Health Services Director to contract with the State Department of Mental Health, (now known as the Department of Health Care Services) to assume responsibility for Medi-Cal specialty mental health services. Responsibility for outpatient specialty mental health services involves contracts with individual, group and organizational providers to deliver these services.
