ADOPT Resolution No 2019/503 approving and authorizing the District Attorney, or designee, to submit an application and execute a grant award agreement, and any extensions or amendments thereof, pursuant to State guidelines, with the California Department of Insurance for funding of the Automobile Insurance Fraud Prosecution Program in an amount not to exceed \$634,297 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. (100%State)

# FISCAL IMPACT:

\$634,297. 100% State, no county match. The grant will fund salaries and benefits for Deputy District Attorneys, a Senior Inspector, a Legal Assistant, and small amounts of other staff time assigned to the program. Supplantation is prohibited.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The State Legislature has determined that one of the significant factors driving up the cost of automobile insurance is fraud. While fraud is recognized as a growing problem across the country, California is an area of concerted criminal activity in insurance fraud. The Automobile Insurance Fraud Prosecution award is allocated from a trust fund financed by
