FISCAL IMPACT:

The HHC competitive funds available to Contra Costa County are up to \$20,000,000 from award acceptance through June 30, 2023. No County funds required.

The State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development issued a Notice of Funding Availability dated May 13, 2019, under the Building Homes and Jobs Act (SB 2) Allocation funds for the Housing for a Healthy California Program.
