FISCAL IMPACT:


There is no impact to the General Fund for this contract extension. The original contract and this extension are funded by the dedicated Recorder Modernization Trust Fund (2451). The contract extension will increase the payment limit by \$262,132, from \$1,048,528 to \$1,310,660.

BACKGROUND:

The County recently contracted with Granicus, LLC, for a Clerk-Recorder Integrated Electronic Recording, Cashiering, Indexing & Imaging System to replace the Clerk-Recorder's existing system provided by SouthTech. During the transition to the new system, the Clerk-Recorder Division requires the continued use of the existing system to
