Subject: Terminate Contract #74-108-15(5) with Arman Danielyan, M.D., Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to issue a 30-day advance written notice to Arman Danielyan, M.D., Inc., a professional corporation, to terminate Contract #74-108-15(4) for the provision of inpatient Medi-Cal specialty mental health services, effective at the close of business on August 31, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract was funded by 50% Federal Medi-Cal and 50% State Mental Health Realignment Funds.

BACKGROUND:

On June 12, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-108-15(4) with Arman Danielyan, M.D., Inc., for the provision of inpatient Medi-Cal specialty mental health services, for the period from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020.

Approval by the Board of Supervisors will allow the Health Services Department to issue a thirty-day advance written notice to the Contractor, in accordance with General Conditions, Paragraph 5. (Termination) that the Contract is terminated effective at the close of business
