RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of County Contract #76-544-4 with Dayana Carcamo-Molina, M.D., Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,470,000, to provide gastroenterology services for Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC) and Health Centers patients, for the period August 1, 2019 through July 31, 2022.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On May 2, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #76-544-2 (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreement #76-544-3) with Dayana Carcamo-Molina, M.D, Inc., to provide gastroenterology services at CCRMC and Health Centers, including clinic coverage, surgical procedures, on-call and administrative support services, for the period May 1, 2017 through July 31, 2019.
