RECOMMENDATION(S):

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this Grant Agreement will result in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 in funding from Kaiser Foundation Hospitals. Approximately 30% (\$9,193) County match is required.

BACKGROUND:

The goal of the East County Moves Program is to increase the knowledge of, access to, and occurrence of healthy food sources and outdoor sites for physical activity among low-income residents in Pittsburg and Bay Point; and increase capacity of Healthy & Livable Pittsburg agencies to evaluate health programming and seek funding to increase further offerings.
