RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #77-116-2 with Professional Healthcare At Home, LLC (dba Kindred Hospice/Kindred At Home), in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000, to provide home healthcare and hospice services for Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members for the period from September 1, 2019 through August 31, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II.

BACKGROUND:

On August 15, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #77-116 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #77-116-1) with Professional Healthcare At Home, LLC (dba Kindred Hospice/Kindred At Home), to provide home healthcare services for CCHP members for the period from September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2019.
