BACKGROUND:

The Board of Supervisors received correspondence from Gallery & Barton, a law corporation representing Reclamation District 2122 (Winter Island). On behalf of the Reclamation District, Gallery & Barton has requested the Board of Supervisors to make an appointment to fill one seat on the District's Board of Trustees in lieu of election.

The District received only one nomination for the open seat, and the sole application was filed by incumbent, Otome Lindsey. Pursuant to Water Code section 50741, the District published notice that the election has been canceled. The District has not received any petitions from landowners requesting an election be held. Therefore, the District requests that the incumbent be appointed, pursuant to Water Code section 50740-50742. Otome
