BACKGROUND:

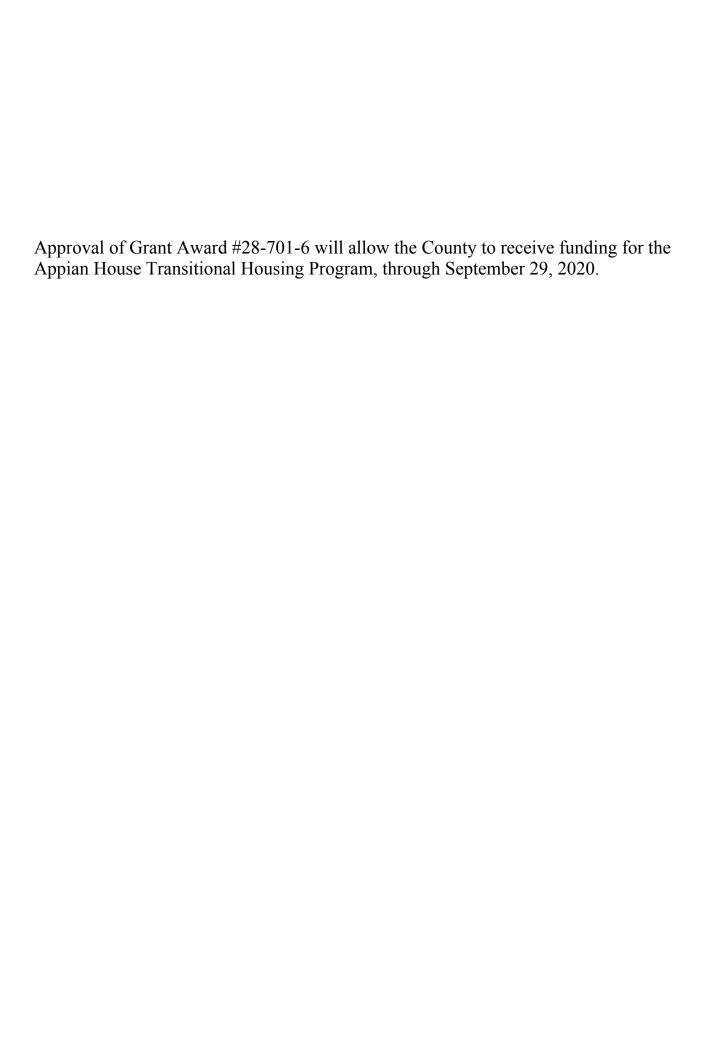
