Subject: Contract #27-420-8 with Pinnacle Mental Wellness Group, a Family Counseling Community, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #27-420-8 with Pinnacle Mental Wellness Group, a Family Counseling Community, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 to provide outpatient psychotherapy services to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members, for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On January 9, 2018 (as corrected on June 5, 2018), the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-420-7 with Pinnacle Mental Wellness Group, for the provision of outpatient psychotherapy services to CCHP members for the period from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019.

Approval of Contract #27-420-8 will allow the contractor to continue providing outpatient psychotherapy services through December 31, 2021.
