**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract #27-896-4 with Serramonte Pulmonary Asthma Sleep Clinic, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000, to provide pulmonary and sleep study services to Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) members, for the period from December 1, 2019 through November 30, 2021.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Contract is funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund II.

**BACKGROUND:**

In May 2017, the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed Contract #27-896-2 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #27-896-3) with Serramonte Pulmonary Asthma Sleep Clinic, Inc., to provide pulmonary and sleep study services to CCHP members, for the period from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2019.
