FISCAL IMPACT:

Submission of this application could result in an amount not to exceed \$5,208,141 in funding from State of California, BCSH. (No County match is required)

BACKGROUND:

On July 31, 2019, Governor Newsom signed into law the HHAP program (Assembly Bill 101, Chapter 159, Statutes of 2019). The HHAP program is a block grant program designed to provide jurisdictions with one-time grant funds to support regional coordination and expand or develop local capacity to address their immediate homelessness challenges
