BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Department will use the 2020 On-Call Facilities General Construction Services Contract(s) to provide general construction services, as needed, for repairs including but not limited to maintenance, repairs and small construction, in support of maintenance operations at various facilities within Contra Costa County.

The Public Works Department intends to award at least one (1), but not more than three (3) contracts, total of contracts not to exceed \$10,000,000 to the responsible bidder(s). Each
