RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract Amendment Agreement #74-218-18 with Desarrollo Familiar, Inc. (dba Familias Unidas), a non-profit corporation, effective March 1, 2020, to amend Novation Contract #74-218-17, to increase the payment limit by \$10,646, from \$399,220 to a new payment limit of \$409,866, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, and to increase the automatic extension payment limit by \$15,969, from \$199,610 to a new payment limit of \$215,579, through December 31, 2020.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded by 50% Federal Medi-Cal; 50% State Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT). (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing community-based mental health services, including assessments; individual, group, and family counseling; case management; and outreach to an underserved Latino population in West Contra Costa County, which will result in greater home, community, and school success.

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On July 9, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74–218–17 with Desarrollo Familiar, Inc.
