Subject: Amendment #24-928-29 with Fred Finch Youth Center

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County Contract Amendment Agreement #24-928-29 with Fred Finch Youth Center, a non-profit corporation, effective March 1, 2020, to amend Novation Contract #24-928-28, to increase the payment limit by \$35,575, from \$1,334,068 to a new payment limit of \$1,369,643, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, and to increase the automatic extension payment limit by \$52,563 from \$667,034 to a new payment limit of \$719,597 through December 31, 2020.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This amendment is funded by 49% Federal Medi-Cal, 49% Mental Health Realignment and 2% Mt. Diablo Unified School District. (Rate increase)

**BACKGROUND:**

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing school and community based mental health services including: assessments, individual, group and family therapy, medication support, case management, outreach, Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS) and crisis intervention services for Seriously Emotionally Disturbed (SED)

## BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On September 10, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #24-928-28 with Fred Finch Youth Center, to provide school-based day treatment and mental health services for students in the Mt. Diablo Unified School District, for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2020.

Approval of Contract Amendment Agreement #24-928-29 will allow the Contractor to continue to provide services through June 30, 2020.

## CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this amendment is not approved, Contractor will not receive the negotiated rate increase.
