
FISCAL IMPACT:

This contract is entirely federally funded by Administration for Children and Families: CFDA No. 93.600. There are no County costs.

BACKGROUND:

Contra Costa County receives funds from the Administration for Children and Families (ACF) to provide Head Start and Early Head Start program services to program eligible County residents. The Department, in turn, contracts with a number of community-based

BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

to provide a wider distribution of services. On September 17, 2019 (c.41) the board approved a contract for the provision of 180 program slot / Head Start and Early Head Start services to program eligible children and families in Contra Costa County. This amendment is to add \$88,992 to the contract and to add twelve additional Early Head Start partnership slots, effective April 1, 2020.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If not approved, County will not be able to provide increased services through this agency.
