Subject: California Department of Aging - Area Agency on Aging Additional Funding

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE Appropriations and Revenue Adjustment No. 5059 authorizing new revenue in the amount of \$112,857 from the California Department of Aging, Emergency Nutrition Funding- Families First Coronavirus Response Act, and appropriating it for Senior Nutrition services, in the Employment and Human Services Department.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total Emergency Nutrition Funding allocation was \$677,138. This appropriation adjustment reflects 3 months (April, May, and June 2020) of the total, 18 month (March 20, 2020 through September 30, 2021) award amount. Funding is 100% Federal. Fiscal Year 19/20 revenues and appropriations will increase by \$112,857.

BACKGROUND:

In March 2020, Contra Costa County Employment and Human Services Department received additional funding due to the National Emergency Declaration. The Emergency Nutrition Funding, Families First Coronavirus Response Act (HR 6201) is awarded for the period of March 20, 2020 through September 30, 2021. This Appropriation Adjustment reflects 3 months of the program applied to FY19/20.
