RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Service Director, or designee to execute Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) #28-917 with the The Regents of University of California, on behalf of the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) for no-cost mutual aid COVID-19 testing services, for the period May 1, 2020 for a period of thirty (30) days which may be extended for additional period during term of the existing public health emergency.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no cost to the County associated with signing this MOU.

BACKGROUND:

UCSF has agreed based upon the public health emergency, and the collaborative effort and mutual aid objectives of this project, to provide COVID-19 testing services, including as appropriate, preparation and testing of patient specimens at no cost to the County. This MOU includes agreement to indemnify and hold harmless UCSF.
